REGISTRATION

Registration requires paying for 1st Month + annual membership fee (\$35 individual/\$50 family). For your convenience, and to reserve a space for the following season, annual membership fees will be automatically renewed and applied to your account on May 1, 2022 unless a withdrawal form is completed in the office before that date.

TUITION

Tuition rates are for the full season (including studio holidays), not by the number of classes in a month. A full season of dance includes a minimum of 33-36 lessons. Tuition and fees are paid monthly or annually. Tuition is due on the 1st of the month.

ATTIRE

Proper attire and hair etiquette are required for all classes. Special class attire including shoes and hair will be published in the August newsletter. All required items will be available in our Dance Boutique.

CLASSES

- THSD reserves the right to reschedule or combine classes or to provide a substitute.
- THSD reserves the right to deliver class content via an online system in the event that classes are not able to be conducted live for any reason including, but not limited to: weather, teacher absence, or governmental advisory.

PERFORMANCES

We end our season with our Spring Showcase. We encourage but do not require participation. The Spring Showcase will be held either in May or June depending on local theater availability.

Costume fee: \$85 per class, due 11/15

Tickets: TBA, available for purchase in April via a ticketing service (date TBA)

Showcase schedules, locations and other information will be published after Christmas Break.



STUDENT LEADERSHIP **PROGRAM**

We are committed to providing leadership training for our students beyond the dance classroom. To that end, students may apply in August for the following opportunities:

Age 11+ - Classroom Helpers assist teachers in the classroom a minimum of 30 minutes per week and receive leadership training twice per year.

PAYMENT

Tuition fees are paid monthly.

- The dance season starts September 7th and goes through the Spring Showcase, which will be in May, depending on venue availability. If the recital is held in May. May 1st will be the last tuition payment of the season.
- After registering, monthly tuition is paid by automatic EFT, debit, or credit card payment on the 1st day of each remaining month.
- There is a \$35 fee on NSF accounts and a \$15 fee on late accounts.
